# RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION INFORMATION

All materials must be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection. No items may be placed at the curb for collection on weekends, and no items should be placed at the curb before holidays unless it is a scheduled collection day in accordance with the annual Holiday Collection Schedule.

All household waste (*i.e.*, "garbage") is collected Monday and Thursday (Route A) OR Tuesday and Friday (Route B), except as noted otherwise in the annual Holiday Collection Schedule.

## **MONDAY**

## Household Waste Collection:

Route A – Monday and Thursday Residential Area and Commercial Area and Apartment Buildings Collection

## Yard Waste Collection:

Route A – Monday and Thursday Residential Area

10 Item Limit – Not to exceed 250 pounds in total weight of all items (Items: bag of grass, bundle limbs no longer than 4 feet, etc.)

## **TUESDAY**

## Household Waste Collection:

Route B – Tuesday and Friday Residential Area and Commercial Area Collection

## Yard Waste Collection:

Route B - Tuesday and Friday Residential Area

10 Item Limit – Not to exceed 250 pounds in total weight of all items (Items: bag of grass, bundle limbs no longer than 4 feet, etc.)

## **WEDNESDAY**

#### Waste Collection:

Commercial and Apartment Building Collection Only

#### Recyclables:

Glass, Metal Cans and No. 1 and No. 2 Plastics Only – **Entire Village** 

Check the triangle on the bottom of the bottle/container. Any number other than No. 1 or No. 2 plastics should be discarded with household garbage, as well as fast food cups or containers, red plastic cups, plastic cutlery, etc. Do not place recyclables in plastic bags - All food residue must be cleaned from Recyclable items

## **THURSDAY**

## Household Waste Collection:

Route A – Monday and Thursday Residential Area and Commercial Area Collection

## **Rubbish Collection:**

Large Bulk Items – Route A – Monday and Thursday Residential Area and Commercial Area

10 Item Limit – Not to exceed 250 pounds in total weight of all items (i.e. – tables, chairs, mattresses, etc.)

## $\frac{Newspaper\ and\ Corrugated\ Brown\ Cardboard\ Collection}{Route\ A-Monday\ and\ Thursday}$

Newspaper and brown plain cardboard boxes only. Pizza boxes, cereal boxes or anything with graphics or waxy coatings are <u>not</u> recyclable and these should be disposed of with household waste

#### **FRIDAY**

## **Household Waste Collection:**

Route B – Tuesday and Friday Residential Area and Commercial Area and Apartment Buildings Collection

## Rubbish Collection:

Large Bulk Items – Route B – Tuesday and Friday Residential Area, Commercial Area, Apartment Buildings

10 Item Limit – Not to exceed 250 pounds in total weight of all items (i.e. – tables, chairs, mattresses, etc.)

## Newspaper and Corrugated Brown Cardboard Collection: Route B – Tuesday and Friday

Newspaper and brown plain cardboard boxes only. Pizza boxes, cereal boxes or anything with graphics or waxy coatings are <u>not</u> recyclable and these should be disposed of with household waste

- As per the Village Code, all metal/white goods/appliances are to be collected by appointment only. There is a two item limit. Please call 746-6791 to schedule pick up.
- Disposal of any flammable liquids or items, construction and demolition debris, propane tanks and tires are strictly prohibited.
- Placing garbage cans or other items out for collection on weekends/holidays is strictly prohibited.

# RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION INFORMATION

## **Notes on Refuse Collections:**

- There is a 10-bag/item limit each collection day with a weight limit of 250 pounds total per garbage collection day, except where noted.
- Tree limbs must be cut in 4' lengths, tied and bundled.
- Leaves are picked up from November 1 through December 15. See "Leaf Removal Program" on page 7 for details.
- Power tools such as lawnmowers, edgers, and other gasoline-powered equipment must be drained of all fluids and placed at the curb on your rubbish collection day.
- Household hazardous waste such as oil, gasoline, pesticides, and paints are collected by the Town of North Hempstead's S.T.O.P. Program. See "S.T.O.P. Program" below for details.
- Propane tanks, flammable liquids, construction and demolition debris and tires are not collected by the Sanitation Division. Propane tanks must be returned to authorized dealers. Tires should be recycled by tire dealers.
- Access to rear yard for residential household waste collection: A clear, unobstructed path at least 4 feet wide must be provided for collection of residential waste from rear yards.

## S.T.O.P. Program

(Stop Throwing Out Pollutants)

The Town of North Hempstead's S.T.O.P. (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) program offers residents of North Hempstead the opportunity to safely dispose of their household hazardous waste, electronic waste (E-Waste), compact fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable, lithium, button, car batteries and more.

S.T.O.P. events are scheduled several times throughout the year. See the Town of North Hempstead website at www.northhempsteadny.gov/STOPprogram for dates and locations of S.T.O.P. events.

The Town of North Hempstead no longer collects pharmaceuticals at S.T.O.P. events. To dispose of pharmaceuticals, please bring them to your local police precinct or attend a Town "Shed the Meds" event.

## **SNOW REGULATIONS**

## **Parking Prohibited During and After Snowfall**

No owner or operator of a motor vehicle shall park the same unattended on any road, street, avenue or highway within the Incorporated Village of Mineola whenever two (2) inches of snow or more falls. No vehicle shall be returned to the road, street, avenue or highway until the road, street, avenue or highway has been plowed by the local municipality. The owner of any vehicle in violation of this local law will be summonsed and fined. All motorists are urged to cooperate during snow emergencies.

## **Cleaning Sidewalks**

The snow season is here and all residents and business owners/tenants are reminded of the local law pertaining to the cleaning of sidewalks: No person occupying any private dwelling and no person owning or exclusively controlling any other premises, either vacant or improved, shall permit any sidewalk in front of or contiguous to such premises to remain covered, obstructed or encumbered with ice, snow, dirt, filth, weeds or any other obstructions or encumbrances for more than two (2) hours after a reasonable opportunity has been had to remove same. Debris and snow may not be placed in roadways.

If your normal collection days are Tuesday and Friday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Tuesday, July 2. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Friday, July 5.

There is No Newspaper/Cardboard collection in weeks when there is a holiday.

If your normal collection days are Tuesday and Friday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Tuesday, November 26. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Friday, November 29.

#### CHRISTMAS EVE and CHRISTMAS DAY

Tues., December 24, 2024 Village Offices Close at Noon Wednesday, December 25, 2024 Village Offices Closed

If your normal collection days are Monday and Thursday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Monday, December 23. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Thursday, December 26.

If your normal collection days are Tuesday and Friday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Tuesday, December 24. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Friday, December 27.

## **NEW YEAR'S EVE and NEW YEAR'S DAY**

Tues., December 31, 2024 Village Offices Close at Noon Wednesday, January 1, 2025 Village Offices Closed

If your normal collection days are Monday and Thursday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Monday, December 30. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Thursday, January 2.

If your normal collection days are Tuesday and Friday, there will be no change to your garbage collection schedule. <u>Yard Waste</u> will be collected Tuesday, December 31. <u>Rubbish and Recycling</u> will be collected Friday, January 3.

There is No Newspaper/Cardboard collection in weeks when there is a holiday.

# LEAF REMOVAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

- In general, the Leaf Removal Program begins during the first full week of November.
- The Highway Division leaf removal crews will remove leaves from our streets following the street sweeping schedule. At the beginning of the Leaf Removal Program, the leaf removal crews will be able to move quickly and may do more than one sweeper route each day. As the Leaf Removal Program progresses and the volume of leaves increases, there may be times the crews will be unable to complete each route, each day. If this occurs, the next day the crews will begin where they left off on the previous day. Every effort will be made to service each area as quickly as possible.
- The Sanitation Division will collect up to 10 leaf bags a day on each garbage collection day.

## Route A — Monday/Thursday Garbage Collection Schedule

Up to 10 leaf bags may be placed at the curb, in front of each home, on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

## Route B — Tuesday/Friday Garbage Collection Schedule

Up to 10 leaf bags may be placed at the curb, in front of each home, on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays.

- Residents and landscape contractors are not permitted to rake, blow, or otherwise deposit leaves
  from private property into the street because piles of leaves pose a hazard of on-street flooding during rains and potential car fires when leaves are dry. Additionally, piling leaves from private property into the street slows our removal crew's attempts to keep our streets clean. Anyone found doing so
  may be subject to a summons and fine.
- In general, the Leaf Removal Program concludes by mid-December. The exact end date may differ from year to year based upon weather conditions, how fast the leaves fall, and how fast our leaf removal crews are able to move through our streets.
