LEISURE PASS PROCEDURE

Leisure Passes may be obtained at the Village Hall Recreation Department located at 155 Washington Avenue. **Registration and photographs are by appointment only (746-0750 ext. 268 or 237).** Hours are from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Evening hours are also offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. You must submit proof of residency as required on the Leisure Pass Application. All residents 3 years and older must have a Leisure Pass.

Beginning June 15th, registration will take place at the pool. Hours are 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. daily. Call the Leisure Pass Office at 746-1576. Once the Leisure Pass Office moves to the pool all passes need to be picked up at that location (passes will not be mailed after June 13th).

Please note: Leisure Pass Office will be closed Memorial Day weekend (May 25-27), Friday June 14, Thursday July 4 and Monday September 2.

Leisure Pass Cost and Terms

\$10.00 per pass (anyone who applies for a pass after June 1st will pay \$15.00 per pass). Cash or check only. You must be a legal resident of Mineola and show proof as required in the Leisure Pass Application. You must sign for receipt of the pass. New applications take 3 business days to process. All 2023 pass holders need to allow one business day for their application to be processed. All fees are non-refundable.

Lost Passes

A replacement pass will be issued with a \$10.00 payment per lost pass. Children 14 or under need a signed statement by a parent or guardian indicating lost pass.

LEISURE PASS USAGE

Leisure Passes are required for entrance to the pool, swimming lessons and other pool-related recreational activities. When visiting the pool, the Leisure Pass must be carried with you. If you leave the area you will need your Leisure Pass in order to be re-admitted. If you did not receive an application in the mail, call 746-0750 ext. 268 or 237 or visit the Village website to download an application. After June 15th call 746-1576. Any resident planning to use the handicap entrance must provide their handicap placard when applying for a leisure pass.

Caretaker Fee:

This is a special pass that entitles the holder to use the Village facilities when accompanying a member of the family with whom they are associated. \$75.00 Limited to one per household. All fees are non-refundable.

Guest Passes:

MEMBERS ARE LIMITED TO TWO (2) GUESTS PER DAY. Should you have extenuating circumstances that might require special attention please see the Pool Director and/or Supervisor on staff.

Members must be 18 years or older to purchase a guest pass and must remain with their guest(s) at all times during their visit.

- Adults (15 and older) \$10.00 each
- Children (14 and under) \$7.00 each

Discount Guest Passes:

This Pass can be purchased at the Pool and allows up to six admissions per card. The cost is \$30.00. Please be advised that the rules and regulations of the Nassau County Health Department limit occupancy of the pool. Occasionally, at peak usage time, admission to the pool facilities may be restricted. It is possible that guests will not be admitted on a given day.

SWIMMING LESSONS

All children and adults registering for swimming lessons must have a 2024 Leisure Pass. Swimming lessons range from Level 1 to Level 6. The fee for ALL swimming lessons is \$25 per registrant, cash or check only. All fees are non-refundable.

Level 1 Introduction to Water Skills

Please Note: Child must be 4 years old, potty trained and able to stand in the 3 foot section independently.

Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills

Level 3 Stroke Development

Level 4 Stroke Improvement

Level 5 Stroke Refinement

Level 6 Swimming and Skill Proficiency

Registration

Registration for Session I, Session II, and Adult Lessons will be held ONE DAY ONLY, ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. Registration day will be on **Saturday**, **June 22nd at 8:00 a.m.** at the front gate of the John S. DaVanzo Community Pool.

In order to give everyone a fair opportunity, only parents of the child being registered for lessons will be permitted to register their child.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Only under certain circumstances can a family member other than a parent register a child. Please call the pool for more information. Parents must have their 2024 Leisure Pass with them in order to register their child. Once all classes are filled registration will be closed for that particular class. Additionally, children are entitled to one session only, even if there is availability in the second session. Registration closes once classes begin.

SWIMMING LESSONS

Children's classes run Tuesday through Friday beginning at 10:00 a.m. and run on half hour intervals until 12:00 p.m. for three weeks. Adult classes are held on TUESDAYS ONLY from 7:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Classes are held rain or shine (lessons are only cancelled due to downpouring rain, thunder and/or lightning). Please call ahead if you are uncertain. Session I and Adult lessons begin Tuesday, July 2nd. Session II lessons begin Tuesday, July 23rd.

If a child is not registered for a class, they are not able to fill in for a child that is absent or has dropped out. Attendance will be taken at every class.

Please Note: If your child is absent three or more times they will not pass that level. If you know your child will be unable to attend three or more classes please do not register your child.

For your convenience there will be swim instructors present at registration to answer any questions you may have.

If you are unsure what level your child should be in, a water safety instructor can test your child's swimming ability to determine the appropriate level before the registration date.



SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM

The Village of Mineola Summer Recreation Program is entering its 36th year. The program is open to all legal residents who are entering 2nd through 6th grade in September and have a 2024 Leisure Pass. The program will begin on Monday, July 1st and end on Friday, August 2nd. Hours for the program are 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.

Applications are available at the Recreation Office located at 155 Washington Avenue beginning April through Thursday, June 13th or can be downloaded from the Village website. Applications received after Friday, June 7th will incur a late fee.

SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM

Any applications received after June 7th will be charged a late fee of \$25.00 per child and applications received once camp begins will be charged a late fee of \$50.00 per child. All fees are non-refundable. Cash or check only. We look forward to seeing many familiar faces again and some new ones as well this summer.


