Resolution No. 28-16

Resolved to create a commercial facade improvement assistance program to assist commercial building owners and tenants within designated areas in the Village;

Finding it in the best interest of the Village, consistent with its Master Plan, Downtown Revitalization Recommendations and as recommended by the Village's Community Development Coordinator, Tom Savino of Vision Accomplished, the Village Board resolves to begin a Facade Improvement Assistance Program (Facade Assistance) funded through Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) Commercial Rehabilitation lines and other grant funds that may become applicable in the future;

Funding will continue each CDBG budget year until the Board of Trustees duly resolves to end the Facade Assistance Program, provided that any funds that have been

awarded shall be retained in the Facade Assistance Program to be disbursed upon completion and approval of the project;

To begin the program, the Board authorizes Vision Accomplished to engage a sub contractor to create the necessary building attribute's database for commercial buildings as assigned. The database will include items like current photos, store front measurements, sign band location and other data needed for grant allocation and protocol. Vision Accomplished will charge the Village for these services independent of its contract terms and such charges will be covered by CDBG funds;

The Board authorizes Vision Accomplished to issue Requests for Proposals (RFPs), for review by the person or persons designated by the Mayor to the following professionals:

- Qualified urban architectural design professionals for reviewing the "vision" and history of Mineola Village downtown areas, in consultation with persons designated by the Mayor to recommend and illustrate exterior facade improvements to be accomplished to create a more inviting, aesthetically pleasing and harmonious downtown appearance; and,
- Qualified commercial facade sign makers with experience, knowledge and the ability to design, craft and install decorative commercial building signs that meet the guidelines and specifications of the Village, qualified to work in Nassau County and meet the requirements of federal HUD regulations, as any may apply; and,
- Experienced commercial building electricians with know-how and ability to supply and install commercial sign and wall light fixtures as may be ordered, meet the guidelines and specifications of the Village, qualified to work in Nassau County and meet the requirements of federal HUD regulations, as any may apply; and,
- Experienced awning supply and installation companies with know-how and ability to supply and install commercial awnings that meet the guidelines and specifications of the Village, qualified to work in Nassau County and meet the requirements of federal HUD regulations, as any may apply; and,
- Experienced exterior facade improvement contractors with the know-how and ability to install or improve commercial building wall surfaces (e.g., stucco, brick pointing, etching), store front windows, doors, paint, etc. It is anticipated that these services will be required on a limited basis and either recommended to commercial building owners for private payments or included where necessary and approved as part of the Facade Improvement Assistance Program and, in those instances with application and adherence to Davis Bacon regulations;

All procurement will seek to reach out and include opportunities for qualified women and minority owned business enterprises, particularly Long Island based and Nassau County approved firms. It is the intent of the Village to engage one professional in each category under a two-year requirement's contract, renewable for one-year intervals, twice, to supply and install items and materials as specifically ordered and scheduled. Qualifications will include satisfaction of all applicable Village, Nassau County, and HUD regulations including adequate certificates of insurance naming the Village of Mineola and Nassau County as additional insured.

The following guidelines will apply to the Facade Assistance Program:

- 1) The Village will offer selected commercial building owners the opportunity to participate in the Facade Improvement Assistance Program and receive an award equal to the cost of 75% of items, materials and installation, as approved and contracted. Owners will contribute a minimum of 25% of the final cost;
- The Village's Facade Improvement Assistance Program contribution (75% portion) will have maximums of \$15,000 for signs, lights, awnings, and related accessories (i.e., all non Davis-Bacon contract work) and up to \$30,000 for projects that also include painting or structural work done by a contractor and applying Davis-Bacon;
- 3) The Village, in working with the Community Development Coordinator will seek to set priorities, rank and score eligible commercial buildings within designated downtown zones, as it determined and approved by the Mayor as objectively as possible. Such score will be used to determine allocation of funding award able to each eligible building;
- 4) Non-eligible participants include any building, owner, or tenant with an unsatisfied violation of a Village or Nassau County code, law, or ordinance. If they are currently adjudicating such violation without final decision, the prohibition for participation is not applicable. The Village will retain the right to stop any project if such violation is not satisfied when required;
- 5) Proper advance announcement will be sent to eligible buildings. Such notification will be as approved by the Mayor;
- 6) Vision Accomplished will administer the Facade Improvement Assistance Program and communicate in follow up with all building applicable owners and tenants to encourage and facilitate participation as needed;
- 7) All participants will enter into a written agreement with the Village in order to confirm all terms of work, including estimate project cost, payments and payment schedule.
- 8) The Village will specifically declare that it accepts no responsibility, warranty or guarantee for the materials, installation, performance or quality of any work;
- 9) Vision Accomplished will oversee and monitor the CDBG budget and determine expense allocations to carefully track, schedule and coordinate expenditures during the CDBG fiscal year (Sept Aug);
- 10) Administration of the program will be in conformance with policies and procedures of the Village of Mineola currently in place and hereinafter enacted. The Village reserves the right to amend, modify, and/or waive any Village requirements it deems necessary in order to meet the goals of the Program; the requirements of Nassau county; and/or the federal HUD regulations;
- 11) The Village reserves the right to suspend, modify and/or terminate the Façade Improvement Assistance Program at any time and for any reason.
